Trail Blazes

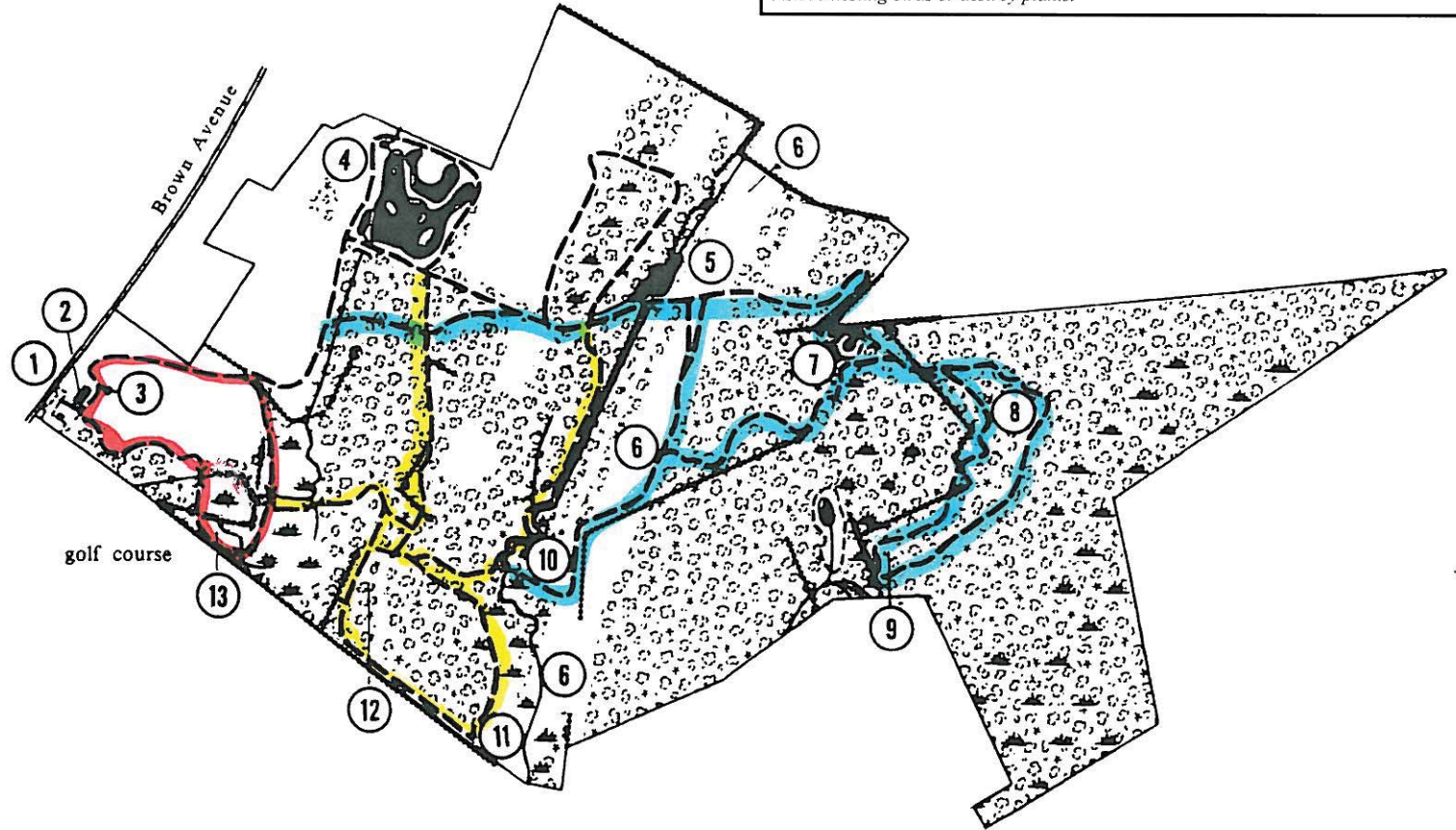
Red - easy, 20 minutes
